#### SUGGESTED MUSICAL RESOURCES

The following can be used for Opening / Parting Hymns, or at other points of the service. Some hymns are grouped by theme, others are suggested for specific parts of the service.

You might wish to begin your service with a Middle Eastern hymn. The hymns grouped under the 'Epiphany / Light' theme could be used between the first and second Scripture readings. The hymns grouped under the 'Unity' theme could be used at appropriate points towards the end of the service.
